### 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Fundraising Proposal

- Opportunity to reach out to past and current members and friends to make a special gift to extend our legacy of worship, service and celebration. A proposed solicitation will be sent via mail and development of a list of major donor prospects in process
- Goal is for a total of \$50,000:
  - \$17,000 Stained Glass Repair
  - \$8,000 Endowment Fund (to cover solar project)
  - o \$15,000 Building Fund ( Parish Hall improvements)
  - \$5,000 Operating Fund (underwriting anniversary events)

- o \$5,000 Outreach Fund
- Hoping to have \$25,000 committed by the July 25<sup>th</sup> Celebration. Have already received \$5,000 towards Stained Glass Windows, \$500 to the Endowment Fund, and \$1,000 to Parish Hall.
- Discussion ensued as to whether it was enough to simply ask for donations to the Anniversary Fund and note the ways it will be spent.
- Would like for 100% participation from the Vestry.

#### Fred's Sabbatical

- The diocese contributed \$1,500 towards Fred Sabbatical. \$1,000 will be reserved for a consultant to review the music program and make suggestions.
- Positive feedback so far on musicians filling in for Fred.

### Pastoral Care Report. John Kirkley

- A brief update was given
- Gwen Buehrens is becoming more involved in Pastoral Care and and also helping the Healing Ministry team

#### **Database Transfer Update**

- Huge improvement; Cloud based, allowing for remote access, more than one user and interactive.
- Membership management will allow for separate contact info for each family member while still displaying the relationship, volunteer and pledge management, service and event attendance tracking, pledge and donation management and QuickBooks Integration are among the things the new database will make easier and more manageable.

## Congregational Renewal Task Force. Carla Borsoi

- Carla Borsoi (Chair), Rev. John Kirkley, Blake Hallanan, Carol Overman, and Tracy Thomas are current members of the Task Force.
- 50 Surveys received and meeting over the weekend to go over the surveys and community interviews.
- Will share highlights at the next Vestry meeting.
- Supervisor Mar spoke last weekend. 22 were in attendance of which 10 were from the community. Major topics were housing for Srs., Safety around traffic, Geary development and new rapid bus lane proposed for 2018 between Arguello and 26<sup>th</sup> Ave.

#### Financial Report: Henry Scarisbrick

#### **Finance Committee:**

- Met the first week of June. Current members are Warren Wong, Chair, Doreen Canton, Henry Scarisbrick, Bill Newlin, Bill Newmeyer and Hap Rhodehamel
- Pledge Reminders sent out
- Reviewed accounting practices
- The Schwab Endowment Fund balance = \$192,758 a/o end of April. A motion was approved to continue with the current investment allocation strategy and to rebalance the fund accordingly.
- Moving to QuickBooks with new Cloud based database. Cost of \$25 per month. Will run parallel systems for a few months to make sure all is running smoothly.
- Warren and Erazm are working on the 2016 Budget and expect to have the first draft in August
- Henry has been added as a signatory to the Union Bank account. Not yet added to the investment account.
- Accounting policy Proposal to write off pledges more than 2-years old
- Meeting for Diocesan Assessment Relief is scheduled for July 6th.
- Have proposed establishing a "Giving Co-ordinator"; someone who can devote 1 hr or so a week to help track and maintain the database, and help in developing new ways of giving,
